To allow Federal law enforcement officers to purchase retired service weapons, and for other purposes.

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Law Enforce-

5 ment Service Weapon Purchase Act".

6 SEC. 2. PURCHASE OF RETIRED HANDGUNS BY FEDERAL

LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

8 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

1	(1) the term "Federal law enforcement officer"
2	has the meaning given the term in section $115(c)(1)$
3	of title 18, United States Code;
4	(2) the term "handgun" has the meaning given
5	the term in section 921(a) of title 18, United States
6	Code; and
7	(3) the term "retired handgun" means any
8	handgun that has been declared surplus by the ap-
9	plicable Federal agency.
10	(b) AUTHORIZATION.—A Federal law enforcement of-
11	ficer may purchase a retired handgun from the Federal
12	agency that issued the handgun to the officer.
13	(c) LIMITATIONS.—A Federal law enforcement officer
14	may purchase a retired handgun under subsection (b) if—
15	(1) the purchase is made during the 6-month
16	period beginning on the date on which the handgun
17	was so retired; and
18	(2) the Federal law enforcement officer is not
19	prohibited from possessing or receiving the handgun
20	under the laws of the United States or the laws of
21	the State, territory, or possession of the United
22	States in which the Federal law enforcement officer
23	resides.

(d) COST.—A handgun purchased under this section
shall be sold at the fair market value for the handgun tak ing into account the age and condition of the handgun.
(e) POLICY GUIDANCE.—The Administrator of Gen eral Services shall develop policies to facilitate the sale and
disposition of eligible handguns under this section con sistent with section 922 of title 18, United States Code.
