Senator Manchin successfully included **\$55,502,000** in funding for **14** projects, also known as “earmarks,” through his Congressionally Directed Spending (CDS) Requests in the Senate Markups of the Fiscal Year 2025 Agriculture and Military Construction & Veterans Affairs Appropriations Bills.
