## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to carry out a program for the construction and renovation of committal shelters at State-owned veterans' cemeteries, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hershel Woody Wil-
- 5 liams State Committal Shelter Act of 2024".

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1	SEC. 2. COMMITTAL STRUCTURES AT STATE-OWNED VET
2	ERANS' CEMETERIES.
3	(a) In General.—Subject to the availability of ap-
4	propriations, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall carry
5	out a program for the construction or renovation of com-
6	mittal shelters at State-owned veterans' cemeteries to en-
7	sure attendees of burial services at such cemeteries are
8	protected from inclement weather (in this section referred
9	to as the "program").
10	(b) Solicitation of Applications.—Not later
11	than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act
12	the Secretary shall solicit applications from States for par-
13	ticipation in the program.
14	(c) Selection of Cemeteries.—
15	(1) In general.—Not later than one year
16	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
17	retary shall select, on a competitive basis, three
18	State-owned veterans' cemeteries for participation in
19	the program.
20	(2) Criteria.—
21	(A) IN GENERAL.—Each cemetery selected
22	by the Secretary for participation in the pro-
23	gram shall be located in an area with drastic
24	variation in annual temperature and weather
25	patterns.

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1	(B) APPALACHIA.—One cemetery selected
2	by the Secretary for participation in the pro-
3	gram shall be located in a State in which each
4	county of that State is served by the Appa-
5	lachian Regional Commission.
6	(3) Priority.—
7	(A) In general.—In selecting cemeteries
8	for participation in the program, the Secretary
9	shall prioritize cemeteries based on relative
10	demonstrated need, as determined by the Sec-
11	retary.
12	(B) Considerations.—In making a de-
13	termination under subparagraph (A), the Sec-
14	retary may consider—
15	(i) the number of veterans' families
16	served by a cemetery; and
17	(ii) the relative severity of weather at
18	a cemetery.
19	(d) Cooperative Agreements.—The Secretary
20	shall carry out the program by entering into a cooperative
21	agreement (as described in section 6305 of title 31, United
22	States Code) with each cemetery selected for participation
23	in the program.
24	(e) COMMITTAL SHELTERS.—At each cemetery se-
25	lected for participation in the program, the Secretary shall

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1	construct one or more new committal shelters, or renovate
2	one or more existing committal shelters, so that each such
3	shelter—
4	(1) is fully enclosed; and
5	(2) has heating, ventilation, air conditioning,
6	and restroom services necessary for hosting not
7	more than 50 individuals.
8	(f) Cost Share Requirement.—
9	(1) IN GENERAL.—The share of the cost of the
10	construction or renovation of a committal shelter
11	under the program shall be as follows:
12	(A) 50 percent Federal funds, subject to
13	paragraph (2).
14	(B) 50 percent funds provided by State or
15	local governments, nonprofit organizations, or
16	private entities.
17	(2) Federal Maximum.—
18	(A) In general.—Each cemetery partici-
19	pating in the program shall receive not more
20	than \$2,000,000 in Federal funds through the
21	program.
22	(B) TOTAL FEDERAL MAXIMUM.—The
23	total Federal share of the cost of construction
24	and renovation of all committal shelters under
25	the program shall not exceed \$5,000,000.

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- 5 1 (g) Use of Funds.—Amounts obligated and expended by the Secretary under the program may be used 3 for any activities that support the construction or renova-4 tion of committal shelters at cemeteries participating in the program, including costs associated with compliance 6 with laws (including regulations). 7 (h) Funding.— 8 (1) Derivation of funds.—Amounts to carry 9 out the program, as provided in advance in appro-10 priations Acts from amounts specifically appro-11 priated to carry out the purposes of this Act, may 12 be derived from amounts appropriated to carry out 13 section 2408 of title 38, United States Code. 14 (2) Maintenance and upkeep.—The Federal 15 16
  - Government shall not be required to provide any amounts for the maintenance or upkeep of any committal shelter after the termination of the cooperative agreement concerned.
- 19 (i) Regulations.—The Secretary shall revise regu-20 lations as necessary to carry out this section.

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
