FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

JUNE 29, 2016

Today, June 25, 2016, President Obama issued a major disaster declaration for the State of West Virginia triggering the release of Federal funds to help individuals and communities recover from the Severe Storms, Flooding, Landslides, and Mudslides that occurred June 22, 2016, and continuing. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Declaration Number: FEMA-4273-DR

Incident: Severe Storms, Flooding, Landslides, and Mudslides

Incident Period: June 22, 2016, and continuing

Federal Coordinating Officer: Albert Lewis
National FCO Program

Individual Assistance (IA): (Assistance to individuals and households):

IA-Designated Counties: Clay, Fayette, Greenbrier, Kanawha, Monroe, Nicholas, **Pocahontas**, Roane, Summers, and **Webster** Counties.

Public Assistance (PA): (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):

PA-Designated Counties: Clay, Fayette, Greenbrier, Kanawha, Monroe, Nicolas, **Pocahontas**, Roane, Summers, and **Webster** Counties for emergency protective measures (Category B), including direct federal assistance, under the Public Assistance program.

Hazard Mitigation (HM): (Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas: All areas in the State of West Virginia are eligible for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER: Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.

Individuals in Clay, Fayette, Greenbrier, Kanawha, Monroe, Nicholas, Pocahontas, Roane, Summers, and Webster Counties can register with FEMA the following ways:
